New Delhi, May 30 (PTI) Criticising the recent hike in fuel prices, central trade unions including Congress-backed INTUC has decided to stage a country-wide protest on June 23.

The decision was taken yesterday at a meeting here of the central trade unions, they said in a statement.

The TUs also decided to extend full support to the united bank strike on July 7.

"The meeting noted with serious concerns that despite several rounds of united protests by the entire trade unions, the Government has totally remained unresponsive to major concerns of the working people," the statement said.

The trade unions feared another round of hike in fuel prices.

The TUs will again meet on June 27 to review the situation and decide their next course of action, the statement added. PTI SGI

A meeting of the Central trade unions held on 29th May 2011 at INTUC office, New Delhi under the presidentship of Shri G Sanjeeva Reddy noted with serious concern that despite several rounds of all in united protests by the entire trade union movement of the country, the government has remained totally unresponsive to major concerns of the working people.

The Central trade unions will again meet on June 27, 2011 at INTUC office at New Delhi to review the situation and decide on higher phase of countrywide united struggles.

Trade unions plan protest against petro-product price hikes

NEW DELHI, MAY 30:

All central trade unions, including the Congress-backed Indian National Trade Union Congress (INTUC), will organise a countrywide protest on June 23 against rising petro-product prices. The move to hike diesel, kerosene and LPG prices after petrol is sure to fuel a further rise in commodity prices, said a joint statement issued by all the trade unions after a joint meeting here on Monday. They also decided to support the strike by bank employees on July 7 and the agitation by coal sector workers, who are meeting on June 27 to decide on their future course of action.
